- Nomination of delegates to be provided by the ANZNN NICU Directors ONLY
- Total of 2-3 medical delegates and 4 sponsored nursing delegates from each ANZNN member NICU may attend. In addition, 1-2 advanced neonatal trainee/fellow/allied health delegate may be nominated.
- · Directors may nominate additional delegates; acceptance will be subject to space availability

 Friday 11th May 2018. This will ensure nominated delegates will be added to the conference mailing list.
