Professor Bill Ledger MA, DPhil (Oxon) BM, BCh, FRANZCOG, FRCOG, CREI is the Head of School of Women's and Children's Health and Professor of Obstetrics & Gynaecology at the University of New South Wales. Bill is also the Director of Reproductive Medicine and Senior Staff Specialist at the Royal Hospital for Women, Randwick and Chair of the Research and

Development Committee and a fertility specialist at IVF-Australia.

His research interests focus on in vitro fertilisation and assisted reproduction, impacts of reproductive ageing and disorders such as endometriosis, premature ovarian failure and polycystic ovary syndrome on fertility and quality of life, reproductive effects of cancer treatment and health economic and demographic aspects of infertility. He has published over 250 peer reviewed research papers and edited 11 books on aspects of reproductive medicine.
